The WebSym system is a stand-alone online software package that is installed on a web server. The XHTML, CSS and Javascript is then inserted through a master administration console.

The WebSym can handle as many sites and as many layouts per site as is required.

The content and features are then assigned through a second client administration console.

To protect IP, WebSym can only be installed on Sympact endorsed or managed servers.

How much does it cost?

The WebSym is sold on a set-up fee and annual maintenance and licence fee model. Costs are based on volume.
